ORD/D.1 **Origin Energy Commits to Major Power Station and Gas Field Development in Queensland**

Summary/Purpose

Mr Robert Connell from Origin Energy joined Council to announce Origin Energy's decision to proceed with the construction of a 630MW gas fired power station near Braemar

- Darling Downs Power Station will be the biggest combined cycle power station in Australia, producing enough power to supply the equivalent of 400,000 Queensland homes
- Origin today completed the contract documents worth \$780M with selected contractors GE and GH2M to construct the power station
- Starts construction middle August 2007, with commissioning to occur in the fourth quarter of 2009
- Intend to establish office in Dalby
- Employ an average of 300 people during construction and up to 25 people once fully operational
- When fully operational the power station will consume up to 44PJ of gas per year
- Gas will be sourced from Origin's extensive coal seam gas reserves at Spring Gully and the Walloon.

The Development Application is to reconfigure the subject land such that two lots are created. The subject allotments meet the minimum allotment size of 500m². However, the location of the sewerage main encumbers the rear portion of proposed lot 4 to a significant extent. This is discussed in greater detail in section 2 of this report.

1. Compliance with the facts and circumstances set out in the application and all Council By-laws being adhered to and generally in accordance with the approved plan (except where varied by conditions of approval).
2. The applicant shall pay to Council a parks contribution at the rate applicable at the time the contribution is paid. The 2006/07 fees and charges indicate \$500 per additional Lot.
3. All outstanding rates and charges shall be paid in full prior to the submission to Council of the Plan of Survey.
4. All conditions of this approval are to be complied with prior to the endorsement of approval of the relevant Plan of Subdivision, unless otherwise stated.

Engineering

5. Registration of an easement in favour of Council with a minimum width of 6.0m (3 metres either side of the sewer main) for the full extent of Council's sewer main where it is within the boundaries of the subject land.
6. Each new Lot shall have vehicular access to the satisfaction of Council and in accordance with appropriate engineering standards.
7. Each proposed Lot shall be separately connected to Council's reticulated water supply system to the satisfaction of Council and to relevant engineering standards.
8. The applicant shall pay to Council a contribution for water supply headworks at the rate applicable at the time the contribution is paid. The 2006/07 fees and charges indicate \$1200 per additional Lot.
9. Each proposed Lot shall be separately connected to Council's reticulated sewerage system to the satisfaction of Council and to relevant engineering standards.
10. The applicant shall pay to Council a contribution for sewerage headworks at the rate applicable at the time the contribution is paid. The 2006/07 fees and charges indicate \$1200 per additional Lot.
11. The applicant shall pay to Council a contribution for transport headworks at the rate applicable at the time the contribution is paid. The 2006/07 fees and charges indicate \$600 per additional Lot.
12. The subject site shall be adequately drained and all stormwater shall be disposed of to the satisfaction of Council and to relevant engineering standards.
13. Any fill placed on the subject land in relation to the development shall not cause any ponding of water on any land beyond.

16. The cost of providing services to each proposed lot and preparing easements shall be at the expense of the applicant.

Environmental Health

17. The operations and construction work associated with this development are to be carried out to the requirements of Council. In particular, no nuisance is to be caused to adjoining residents by the way of smoke, dust, stormwater discharge or siltation of drains, at any time, including non-working hours. Where material is spilled or carried onto existing roads, it is to be removed forthwith so as to restrict dust nuisance and ensure traffic safety. Adequate safety precautions are to be maintained where work is taking place on existing roads and any damage deemed by the Environmental Health Officer to be attributable to the progress of works or vehicles associated with the development of the site shall be repaired to Council's satisfaction.

- (a) The **relevant period** for the development approval (Reconfiguring of a Lot) shall be two (2) years starting the day the approval is granted or takes effect. In accordance with Section 3.5.21(2) of IPA, the development approval for Reconfiguring a Lot lapses if a plan for the reconfiguration is not given to Council under Section 3.7.2(2) within the abovementioned **relevant period**.

An applicant may request Council to extend the **relevant period** provided that such request is made in accordance with Section 3.5.22 of IPA and before the development approval lapses under Section 3.5.21 of IPA.

- (b) Council is to be indemnified against any claims arising from works carried out by the applicant on Council's property.

That it be recommended to Council that the CEO be authorised to prepare contract documents for the three Directors which provide for a redundancy provision if they are unsuccessful in securing a position with the amalgamated Council at the same salary and conditions.
