Community shows interest in Aquatic Centre Project

Interested residents demonstrated their keen interest in the proposed aquatic centre by filling the gallery at last night's special meeting of Council, held to discuss the site location of an aquatic centre in Dalby.

"It was great to see the gallery full of interested residents and for the public to see that Council is still carefully considering the many complex issues associated with this project," said Mayor Cr Warwick Geisel.

"Although some of the gallery may have been disappointed that Council did not ask for their comment last night, that is Council's normal meeting procedure.

"I have personally extended an invitation to all interested community groups to attend a special meeting of Council's aquatic centre project committee to be held Wednesday 27th July at 4pm."

The outcome of last night's meeting is that Council has identified the strengths and weaknesses of its three preferred sites. The existing site incorporating the existing pool, the PCYC site and the site adjacent to the butter factory were discussed at length against 10 key selection criteria.

"The next step for Council is to get feedback from the community to ensure that we have considered all the issues," said Mayor Cr Warwick Geisel.
