WATER RESTRICTIONS

Following record high water consumption in February and the outlook of continued hot weather, Council has retained the current water restrictions.

Residents connected to the Dalby town water supply are restricted to using only hand-held hoses and dripper systems for outdoor use between the hours of 5am – 7am & 5pm – 7pm on their odds and evens watering days.

Watering by non-approved methods, such as the use of sprinklers, watering outside of the restriction hours or on the wrong day is a finable offence.
